

Skyline Education Foundation Inc. Scholarship

The Skyline Education Foundation will be offering scholarships, up to \$1000, to graduating seniors. The scholarship is for deserving seniors who intend to pursue post-high school education in any in-state or out-of-state accredited 4-year or 2-year college, or trade/vocational school. Applicant must graduate with a Skyline diploma with at least a 2.8 cumulative grade point average. The scholarship is for tuition and will be paid when a tuition bill is presented to the Skyline office indicating acceptance at a college/school. Recipients are to take advantage of the scholarship prior to March 1st of the following year, or they will lose the scholarship.

Students are required to submit an essay that is word-processed, double-spaced (not more than two pages) using the guidelines below:

- Provide a brief background of yourself.
- Give reasons for why you want to pursue post-high school education.
- Discuss your long-range post-high school education goals.
- Describe your involvement in extra-curricular and community service activities, and highlight leadership positions during your high school years.
- Tell us about any extenuating circumstance or an interesting event in your life (optional.)
